## The Podium Streak Continues for Team Jimmy John's/ Ski-Doo/BOSS Racing

Winnipeg, Manitoba- February 21, 2012



Team Jimmy John's, rallied to Ski-Doo's home base of Valcourt, Quebec, Canada to participate in the 30th annual running of the internationally acclaimed Grand Prix de Valcourt. The world's top three snocross sanctioning organizations; the International Series of Champions (ISOC), The Canadian Snocross Racing Association (CSRA) and the East Coast Snocross Series (ECS) each converged on the small town, 90 minutes from Montreal to duel it out in the annual confrontation for one of North America's top snocross honors. This annual mecca of snowmobile racing draws close to 30,000 fans each year and showcases snowmobile athletes in several disciplines.

Thursday night, Boss athletes kicked things off by lining up to sign autographs for the first rush of weekend fans at the world famous J. Armand Bombardier Museum adjacent to BRP's world headquarters.

As Saturday's snocross racing got underway, Derek Ellis showed strong in the Pro Stock class securing a first and a third in his qualifying rounds — putting him securely on the front line of the Pro Stock main event. At the start, he pulled a fantastic hole-shot and emerged out of the first turn's pileup in 6th place. Adrenaline was running high as he hard charged through the pack to regain 3 positions; finishing with the 3rd place podium slot.

In Sunday's Pro Open racing, Mathieu Morin had similar qualifying. He finished 3rd and 1st in his qualifying heats which placed him in the number 4 slot on the front line for the big show. At the flag, Mathieu led the elite pack into the first corner. A first turn bottleneck pushed him back to third, but he was hard on the heels of 2nd place. The feisty Morin rode strong and smart as part of the lead pack for most of the race, until a bobble in a rough turn gave Tremblay the momentary window he needed to pass, leaving Morin one spot shy of the podium with a 4th overall.
